

## **Resume Dr. V. Dashevsky**

Dr. Vladimir Dashevsky graduated with honors from the Moscow Institute of Food Industry in 1959. He devoted his entire working life to the development of the grain and food industries. In the labor biography - only three Moscow addresses: the All-Union Research Institute of Grain and Grain Products, the Central Research Institute of Information and Technical and Economic Research of the Grain Products Industry and the International Industrial Academy. He is a Doctor of Technical Sciences, author of more than 150 published works, including English-Russian (five editions) and German-Russian (three editions) Dictionaries of the food industry. He also participated in the drafting and preparation of the publication "Dictionary of Cereal Processing and Cereal Chemistry", 1982 (Russian party). On his initiative and with direct participation in Moscow, more than 350 international forums, conferences, symposia and seminars were held at the International Industrial Academy. Under his leadership, delegations from the grain products industry travelled to many countries. The scientific and social activity of Dr. V. Dashevsky has more than once been highly awarded with awards, among which the title "Honored Worker of the Food Industry of the Russian Federation". He was awarded the gold medal of the Ministry of Agriculture of the Russian Federation "For his contribution to the development of the agro-industrial complex".
